#### Board of Health Amends Local Emergency Rule

The Gallatin City-County Board of Health voted today to amend the local emergency rule to harmonize with Gov. Bullock's revisions to Phase 1 reopening guidelines and allow for the reopening of gyms, museums and theaters in Gallatin County starting May 15.
