ASSISTANCE AT FAIR FOR MOBILITY CHALLENGED Qualicare Brings Assisted Transport to Help Folks Get Around

Bozeman, MT— In partnership with the Bozeman business, Qualicare, the Fair began this program, providing motorized cart rides to destination points within the fairgrounds.

"We pick up at A and B Gates, with multiple stops throughout the route," said Jen Krum, co-owner of Qualicare. The Fair has always been such a fun and bonding part of our summertime community activities and we would hate for anyone to miss out!"

Running daily, those needing assistance moving throughout the grounds can hitch a ride with this cart transportation Wednesday, July 21 through Sunday, July 25. Route stops include A and B Gates, Anderson Arena, The Northwest Farm Credit Services Livestock Tent, Treasure State Stage, and the Exhibit Buildings. The carts run daily about every half hour and bench seating at each stop is provided. The service is available to those fairgoers with mobility challenges.

Qualicare is a home health service providing nurse managed care for their customers. Their provisions include crisis intervention and healthcare support; coordination of healthcare activities; management of a customer's healthcare team; and healthcare plan management and support.
