Press Release COVID-19 Death in Gallatin County

The Gallatin City-County Health Department is saddened to announce that one more Gallatin County resident has passed away from complications due to COVID-19.

The person was a man in his 70s who died at his residence the week of Mar. 1. The Gallatin City-County Health Department yesterday received the official death certificate that attributed his death to COVID-19.

This latest death makes for a total of 57 COVID-related deaths in Gallatin County. Data on statewide deaths reported by the Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services can be found [here](#).

“The Health Department sends our condolences to this man’s family and friends,” said Matt Kelley, Gallatin City-County Health Department Health Officer. “The vaccine demand continues to outweigh the supply in Gallatin County. That means it’s still very important to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 through continued social distancing, avoiding crowds, wearing face coverings, washing hands, and staying home when sick.”

Out of respect for the man’s family, no further details will be released.
